



The District Level Monitoring Committee Meeting on Biomedical Waste Management was held on dated. 25.03.2022 at 05:30 PM under the Chairmanship of Collector & District Magistrate, Jagatsinghpur.

In the meeting the following officials were present.

At the outset, Dr. Kshetrabasi Dash, Chief District Medical & Public Health Officer, Jagatsinghpur welcomed to all members and chairperson to the meeting and presented the aim and objective of the meeting in the house.

The Collector & DM-cum-Chairperson reviewed the last meeting proceeding which was held on dt. 03.03.2021. The DPHO, Jagatsinghpur presented the point wise compliance of the decisions taken in the last meeting.

Compliance of the resolutions of last meeting held on dated.03.03.2021

1. Regarding present status of Biomedical Waste Management activities in the district:
 - Renewal of the Contract Period of the outsourcing agency M/S-Shine Laundry Services Pvt. Ltd., Bhubaneswar have been extended for next 11 months (from 01.02.2022 to 31.12.2022).
 - Biomedical Waste Management activities like: Waste Collection, Transportation, Storage, Treatment & disposal of the district have been outsourced to M/S-Shine Laundry Services Pvt. Ltd., Bhubaneswar.
 - Human anatomical waste have been disposed in concerned containment area of the concerned CHCs and soiled & infected plastic waste transported to DHH containment area for treatment and disposal.
 - COVID waste have been transported to DHH containment area separately with double layered plastic bags and labeled as COVID-19 waste for treatment and disposal.
2. Regarding establishment of Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) of DHH, Jagatsinghpur
 - DPR for the above purpose has been received by this office from the state. it will be established as per decision of the State as discussed in the last BMW meeting at the state level.
3. Regarding disposal of treated Biomedical Waste by incinerator.
 - M/S-Sani Clean Pvt. Ltd, CBWTF, Tangiapada, Khurda was requested for lifting of COVID and Non-COVID waste of the district as per instruction of the Director, Public Health, Odisha.

- On reply M/S-Sani Clean Pvt. Ltd stated that their CBWTF is overloaded and unable to lift the Non-COVID waste and will lift only the COVID waste of Rs. 4,500/- per centre/visit and Rs.100/- per kg. This matter was discussed with the Ex-Collector & DM, Jagatsinghpur and he suggested to collect the rate chart from nearby district i.e from Kendrapara, Anugul & Puri and it is found the disposal rate same in other district but nobody has signed MoU with the agency.
- 4. Regarding identification of space for construction of new containment area:
 - No space available in the hospital premises for new construction.
- 5. Regarding 3 Phase electrification in all CHCs/PHCs.
 - 3 phase electrification have been supplied to CHC Raghunathpur, CHC Mandasahi & CHC Kujanga. An estimate of all CHCs & PHCs has been submitted to DPH, Odisha for placement of funds for this purpose.
- 6. Regarding Consent to Operate (CTO) Status of DHH & FRUs.
 - All DHH & FRUs have been applied CTO for five years. It has been pending at OSPCB, Bhubaneswar.
- 7. Regarding formation of District Environment Plan:
 - It should be under the Chairpersonship of Collector & DM, DFO is the member convenor of the meeting. Collector & DM, Jagatsinghpur has already declared DFO, Rajnagar as Member convenor of District Environmental Committee and requested to convey the meeting vide letter No. 10031, Dt. 18.12.2020. In this regard District Public Health Officer, has already communicated the Biomedical Waste Management Part to DFO, Rajnagar and the District Environmental plan has already been formed for Jagatsinghpur.

Discussion on the basis of agenda points and decision taken thereof:

Regarding present status of Biomedical Waste Management activities in the district:

- Renewal of the Contract Period of the outsourcing agency M/S-Shine Laundry Services Pvt. Ltd., Bhubaneswar have been extended for next 11 months (from 01.02.2022 to 31.12.2022).
- Biomedical Waste Management activities like: Waste Collection, Transportation, Storage, Treatment & disposal of the district have been outsourced to M/S-Shine Laundry Services Pvt. Ltd., Bhubaneswar.
- Human anatomical waste have been disposed in concerned containment area of the concerned CHCs and soiled & infected plastic waste transported to DHH containment area for treatment and disposal.
- COVID waste have been transported to DHH containment area separately with double layered plastic bags (Biodegradable) with labeling as COVID-19 waste for treatment and disposal.

Installation of Autoclave machine.

- Autoclave machine to be installed at CHCs/PHCs after 3 phase electrification.
Responsibility -DPHO, Superintendent of CHCs, Jagatsinghpur

Installation of Shredder machine at DHH

- Now the shredder machine is out of order. Maintenance department KTPL visited and suggested for condemnation that the machine is not repairable. Proposal has been submitted to DPH, Odisha for new machine.

Responsibility - DMO(MS)-cum-Superintendent/Hospital Manager, Jagatsinghpur

Space for construction/renovation of containment area

- It was observed that due to want of adequate place in the DHH premises the containment area not yet been renovated/constructed. Though there is a fund provision for the purpose, it was unanimously decided that the existing deep burial pit in the containment area of DHH needs to be evacuated and renovated to manage the BMWM activities of DHH.
- The Collector & DM advised that nearest CBWTF, M/S-Sani Clean Pvt. Ltd. Bhubaneswar may be contacted for lifting both COVID & Non-COVID waste of entire district. Accordingly, a budget may be prepared and submitted to Director of Public Health, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.
- Participating on the discussion representative of RO, SPCB has pointed out regarding the provision provided under the BMW Rule 2016 and action may be taken accordingly for disposal of BMW in the district (Govt/Pvt. Health facilities).
- It was also discussed that as there is lack of space for construction of containment area at DHH, one agency to be identified for lifting of BMW waste from DHH to CBWTF. Accordingly, an approximate budget to be made for this purpose and to be submitted to the state authority for placement of funds.

CTO Status of FRUs and DHH, Jagatsinghpur


- All DHH & FRUs have been applied CTO (Liquid waste management) for five years. It has been pending at OSPCB, Bhubaneswar.
- Collector & DM instructed to follow up the above activities through OSPCB.
Responsibility - DPHO, CDM&PHO, Hospital Manager, DHH, Jagatsinghpur

Three Phase Electrification at CHCs & PHCs

- Another request letter to be submitted to DPH, Odisha for placement of fund for 3 phase electrification of CHCs & PHCs.
Responsibility - DPHO, Hospital Manager, DHH, Jagatsinghpur


